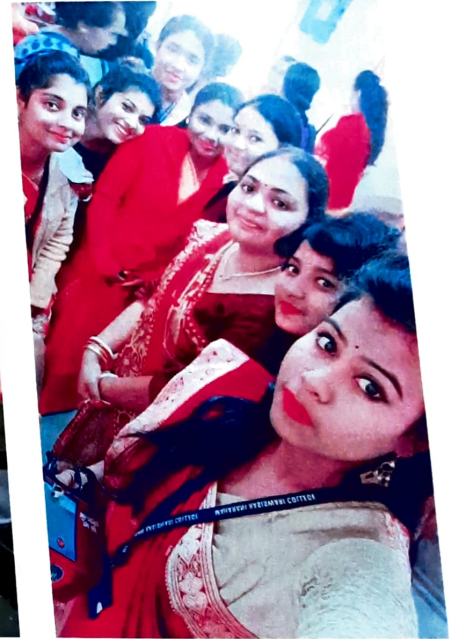
The lecture was delivered by Dr. Ratna Dutta Sharma. She discussed very nicely in a lucid language about the different schools of Indian Philosophy.
